Dear Parents/Carers

We are excited to be taking 1H to Gunnersbury Park on Wednesday 7th May 2025.

We are visiting Gunnersbury Park Museum and attending a Victorian Workshop to learn about the Victorian times and compare this era to our own. Children will handle Victorian artefacts and learn about Victorian school life, toys, jobs, inventions and working conditions.

The children should arrive at school at normal time and wear their full school uniform and comfortable shoes for walking.

*As all children receive Free School Meals, they will automatically receive a school packed lunch. If, however you **do not** wish for your child to receive a school packed lunch, please let your child's class teacher know by ticking your child's name on the provided sheet on the classroom door by **Thursday 1st May, in the morning**. Please note if you do not tell your class teacher, your child will receive a school packed lunch.*

We will be travelling via coach and leaving school at around 9:15am and returning approx. 3pm. If there are any delays, you will be notified by e-mail or text. Please note no child is allowed to walk home alone and must be picked up by an adult from school.

We are asking parents/carers to pay **£20 via ParentPay** towards the cost of the outing, no later than **Monday 5th May**. As usual, we are funding this visit through your contributions. Please note, though this is a voluntary contribution, if insufficient funds are raised we may have to cancel the visit.

I am sure this trip will be an enjoyable experience for everyone.
